The present study aims to examine the role of NEP 2020 in strengthening higher education in Andhra Pradesh so as to support the national vision. The specific objectives include:

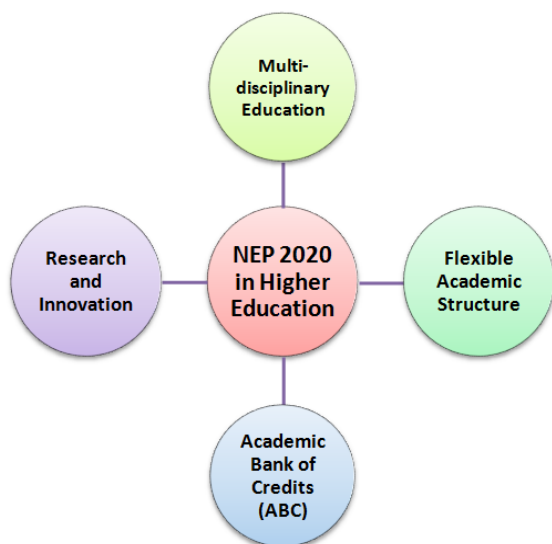
1. To analyze the major reforms proposed in NEP 2020 for higher education.

## OPPORTUNITIES CREATED BY NEP 2020

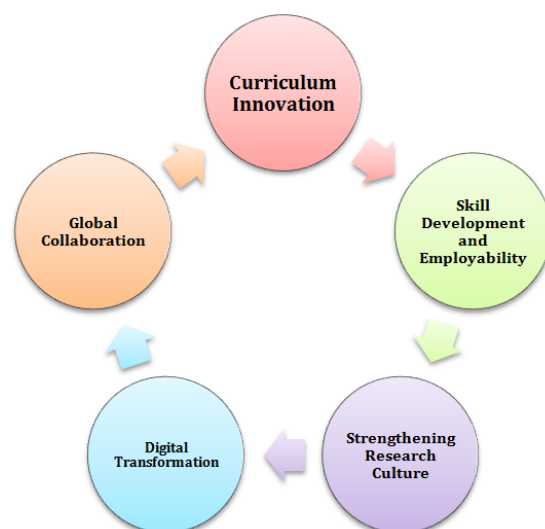
The implementation of NEP 2020 offers several opportunities for HEIs in Andhra Pradesh.

## Digital Transformation

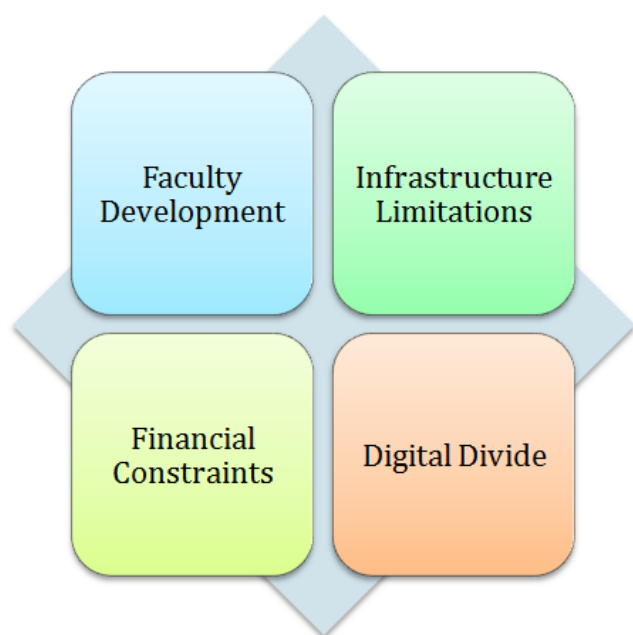
The adoption of digital learning tools enables institutions to reach a wider student population and improve the quality outcomes of teaching and learning programmes.
